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## The Tipping Point Deuteronomy 30

**Focus:** Calling us to turn and be restored to God, no matter how far or how long we have strayed from Him and His will for us.

Read 30.1-5. What is the hope that is present in these verses? How will that play out in the life of Israel? in our lives?

Read 6-10. List all the things that God does for His people in these verses. What responsibilities belong to the people in these verses? How do these two interrelate? What is the hope that is in these verses?

Read 11-14. What do these verses teach us about the commands of God given to his people? how should this shape our view of Scripture?

Read 15-20. How would you restate the choice that is before God's people in your own words? How is their choice our choice as well?

Spend time sharing and praying for one another concerning areas of your lives that need to be brought back into full obedience to God (be sensitive to the promptings/conviction that the Spirit was given during the sermon on Sunday). How should the hope offered in this passage affect your prayers and expectations about these matters?

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
