SG Discussion Questions:

Focus: urging the lost (and believers) to respond to Jesus' call to come to Him and find rest for our souls.

Read verses 25-26. What do you learn about the way salvation (belief in "these things" about Jesus' words and works) from these verses? Why do you think things are hidden from the wise and revealed to children? How should this affect you?

Read verse 27. What do you learn about the way the Trinity works from this verse? What do you learn about salvation? Is it a good thing, in your mind, that Jesus has to choose those that will have salvation revealed to them?

Read verses 28-30. List everything you learn about Jesus from these verses. Which of those insights do you especially treasure? How ought these verses affect the way you share the gospel? How does this offer of rest apply to you? What does it mean for you to respond to that offer?
