## Messy Me and the Hope of the Gospel Colossians 1:13-23

**Purpose of SG:** to foster in its members the biblical values of worship (God), discipleship (church), and outreach (lost).

## **SG Discussion Questions:**

Focus: Helping the church cling to the hope that is ours even in the darkest days.

Read Colossians 1:13-23.

Describe a time when you look into the mirror of God's word and realized what was staring back didn't look anything like Jesus. A time when the weight and reality of your sin was almost to heavy for you to bear.

(13-14) What practical hope could these verses bring to you when you are discouraged and dispondent over your sin?

(15-20) How does this Christ centered hymn help you see Jesus more clearly? As you "behold Christ"(2 Cor 3:18) what do you find exceedingly beautiful, transforming, and hope producing?

How could being re-introduced (over and over) to the Good and Mighty King help you face your daily struggles?

(21-22) How should this gospel (rescue, redemption, reconciliation) bring hope to your daily life? What does it really mean to live reconciled in a sinful world?

(23)If there is no real hope outside of Jesus--then how do we help one another remain stable, steadfast, and not shifting from our hope!
