### **SG Discussion Questions:**

**Focus:** *on embracing the foundational truth that God is one above all other gods and that this fuels our mission and requires our full devotion.*

Read Mark 12.28-30 and Deut. 6.4-5.

The statement, "The Lord our God, the Lord is one", has several different shades of meaning. Discuss the significance of each one:

God is one, He is not many (read Is. 44.6; 45.21; 1 Tim. 1.17). How does this protect us from false gods? How should this affect our view of world missions?

God is One, He is uniquely supreme (read Ps. 86.8; Jer. 10.6-7). How does God's supreme oneness relate to the command to love him with all our heart, soul, mind and strength? How might you do this more fully?

God is One, He is a unity/undivided (read John 6.38-40; 14.26; 17.20-23). How ought God's oneness affect our unity? What does this mean for our relationships?

What is one way the oneness of God ought to be shaping the way you think about God and the way you love and serve Him?
