

Who's Your Eunuch?

Acts 8:26-40

Focus: calling us to obedience in response to the Spirit's leading in sharing Christ.



37 All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never cast out

44 No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him. And I will raise him up on the last day

- John 6.37, 44

Discussion:

Read through the passage aloud together 3 times. Look for one of these things after each time you read it:

1) Look for insights about the will and character of God and the way He works through Phillip and in pursuing the eunuch. Discuss how this should shape how we anticipate God at work through us in sharing Christ.

2) Look for insights about Philip's character and responsiveness to God (you may want to draw on information from earlier in the chapter and ch. 6, too). Discuss how we can follow his example, especially in obedience and readiness to speak of Christ to others.

3) Look for insights about the eunuch's searching heart. Discuss how this might show up in an unbeliever in our day. Discuss how the presence of these folk that God is drawing (cf. Jn. 6.37, 44) should affect the way we think about and engage people in spiritual conversation.

Close your time by praying for those you sense God may be at work in (or for those you long for God to be at work in!). Pray also for your obedience to God's promptings to reach out to them in loving conversation about Christ.
