- Make a list of every insight you see about Saul's conversion from this passage. Which of those observations are true about all conversions to faith in Christ?
- What do you think enabled Ananias to overcome his initial fear and reluctance to go to Saul and minister to him? and what do you think enabled Barnabas to welcome Saul when others refused? How can these men serve as examples for you?
- How should this account of Paul's conversion affect your own willingness to share Christ?
- Share those who might make your list of "least likely to convert". How might God want you to be involved in their becoming a follower of Jesus? steadfast prayer? speaking to them of Christ?
