• What role does prayer play in this story? How does this encourage or challenge you in your own prayer life? What would be a "next step" of growth for you in prayer in light of this passage?

• Why do you think God's judgment was so severe against Herod? (see Is. 42.8). How can this same sin creep into our lives? What comfort and hope comes from the reality of a future, just judgment of God?

• In light of everything else that occurs in this chapter, how is verse 24 an encouragement to you?

• What is the most encouraging thing for you in this chapter? How can you carry that truth with you in a way that strengthens your faith and obedience?
