Pray like Moses, for God's Sake!

Focus: on learning to intercede for others for God's sake, based on his loving character.

Discussion:

- review the setting of Numbers 14 by reading 13:17-14:10. How would you describe God's people at this time?
- Read 14.11-12. What is your reaction to God's proposal to Moses?
- Read 14.13-16. In light of what the people were like and what God just proposed, what impresses your about Moses's request? What is the heart of his prayer? Why do you think he prays like this?
- What forms the basis for his prayer in 14.17-19? Why do you think God was glad to grant his request?
- What would it look like for you to pray like Moses? What makes it hard for you to pray like that?
- What questions do you have about God appearing to change his mind in response to Moses' prayer?
