Mentors in Prayer: Revelation and the Prayers of Angels

Passage: Rev. 4-5

1. When you think about the Book of Revelation, what are the first things that come to mind?
2. "What you believe about the future is one of the best predictors of how you will live today." Do you believe this to be true? Give an example in your life of how this is true.
3. Read Revelation 4-5. Take in the scene for a moment. What do you learn about God the Father, God the Son, and God the Spirit from this scene?
4. Does your wonder in God increase with your knowledge of Him? Or do you find Him less mysterious as you learn more of Him? Is this even a possibility?
5. Share some of your favorite Scriptures that declare God's intrinsic virtues or ascribe Him glory for what He has done. And read them together. Right these down and stick them in your bible to help guide your prayers. Here are some to get you started. (Psalm 29:1-2; Romans 11:33-36; Isaiah 25:1; Psalm 115:1)
6. Spend some time in prayer declaring God's worth, giving thanks for what He has done, and petitioning him for help in keeping our wonder and awe high.
