Loving the Church: Serving One Another

John 13:1-17

Purpose: To encourage us to serve one another in humility and to grow in our love for each other and for the Lord.

Read v.1-5.

- **1.** The scriptures tell us that Jesus was tempted in every way we are. (Hebrews 4:15) Why might it have been hard for Jesus to serve the disciples?
- **2.** How doe the normal rhythms of life discourage us from being servants to one another?
- **3.** Is there an area of service that you aren't willing to do or really don't want to do? What might that say about the condition of your heart?

Read v.6-10.

- 4. Why do you think Peter asked Jesus to wash his hands and his head also?
- 5. What do you think is the most important lesson from verses 6 through 10? Why?

Read v.11-17.

- **6.** In verse 12 the text says, "When he had washed **their** feet..." Why do you think Jesus washed Judas' feet?
- **7**. How can acts of service be an evangelistic exercise? Do you think serving someone makes them more open to the gospel?
