- •Read John 1:35-42
- •Share with the group how you came to faith in Jesus. Was it the result of hearing someone speak in a large group setting, the result of a personal conversation with someone or a combination of these (or some other means)?
- •Jesus called His first two disciples with a challenge ("...what do you seek?")? Why? If Jesus were to ask you today, "What are you seeking?" what would your answer be? If Jesus were to ask your family, close friends or co-workers what you are seeking, would their answer differ from yours and why?
- •Why did Jesus use fisherman (they had seminaries and religious schools then) as the foundation to form the Church to worship Him and proclaim the new age of the Kingdom of God?
- •What motivated Andrew to be so excited and driven? How does Andrew evangelize Peter? Is this the best way to lead people to Christ? What can you learn from his approach?
- •If someone asked you how a person have eternal life with God, what would you tell them? How can you be better at taking the initiative to be a better witness?
