- Read 3.1-6 and list any insights you can glean about Jesus and about the church.
- What are the things the writer mentions in verses 1-2 that we are to consider about Jesus? Which of those do you most need to reflect on?
- What's up with the comparison to Moses in vss. 3-6? What insights about Moses (and this comparison) can you glean from the passage he is quoting in Numbers 12.6-8?
- What is the significance of "holding fast" in v. 6? What if you don't hold fast to our confidence and boasting in Christ?
- How are the following big ideas in this passage related? Considering Jesus, Jesus is greater than Moses, and holding fast to your confidence.
- How must you be more faithful in "considering Jesus"? What should that look like this week?
