- Key Words: Hope/Heaven
- Full statement of priority: to help us more fully grasp the joy and wonder of eternity with God such that we are increasingly:
  - Daily mindful of the heavenly hope that is ours in Christ
  - Willing to persevere in hardship and suffering in light of our hope
  - <u>Eager to offer</u> this hope to the people God has placed in our lives

- Romans 8.18 For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us.

- pray that we would grasp the awesome hope of eternal life with God!
- pray that our vision of heaven (and all that is associated with it) will make our present suffering worth it all such that we would persevere in loving obedience to Christ
